Golf and Tennis Lesson Scholarships:

- Scholarship support is provided by Dakota Junior Golf Association and Bismarck Mandan Tennis Association for golf and tennis lessons.



Outdoor Pool Season Passes (formerly patches):

- In 2024, pass cards are replacing swim patches (save your card and reactivate for the 2025 season).
- Pass cards, which will be scanned at outdoor pools for entry, require photos of all cardholders.
- Outdoor Pool Season Passes are fully waived for all outdoor pools, excluding the Hillside waterslide.
- Season Passes do not cover swimming lesson fees or indoor pool fees at the BSC Aquatic & Wellness Center.

BLAST (Bismarck's Life After School Time):

- There is no discount for this school-year program.

BSC Aquatic & Wellness Center (BSC AWC) and Capital Racquet & Fitness Center (CRFC) - Dual Membership:

- Applicants must meet income qualifications and guidelines to receive a discounted facility membership.

4. If approved for scholarship, you will be notified and additional paperwork may need to be filled out prior to registration.
