To Parents of Soccer Participants:

Thank you for allowing your child to play soccer this summer. We look forward to meeting you, the parents, and our team. We are extremely excited about helping your child expand his/her understanding of the game of soccer! As their coach, our first emphasis will be on fundamentals. We will work with your child to further develop their fundamental skills and hopefully we will have a lot of FUN learning together.

We would ask that each child is respectful. Respectful to us, fellow players, opponents, officials, and those they come in contact with throughout the season. We believe it is important to develop an early understanding of sportsmanship and teamwork. Our focus is to teach your child how to develop their skills and have fun playing the game of soccer. I hope that you also share this philosophy and will discuss and emphasize these concepts with your child throughout the season.

Practice and Game Schedule

We will practice for the full hour during the first two weeks of **team practices**; see the practice schedule for field location. Shirts and picture order forms will be handed out on June 9 & 10. The practice and game schedules will be available on the Bismarck Parks and Recreation District website at www.bisparks.org by Friday, June 13. Starting June 16 & 17, we will practice for the first 15 minutes with a practice/warm-up activity, which will be followed by games of two 20-minute halves and review.
